FAITHFUL TILL DEATH

As the apostle Paul neared the end of his earthly sojourn, he exclaimed, "For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing" (II Tim. 4:6-8). Although the proverbial "clock was ticking" and his time was running out on earth, Paul was not in despair or filled with anxiety. To the contrary, his mindset was that of optimism and courageous confidence.

When Paul penned his final inspired letter to Timothy, his "son in the faith" (I Tim. 1:2), death was imminent. He would soon suffer death at the hands of Nero. All of the trials and labors he had experienced on the battlefield for Christ would culminate in victory. Approximately six years earlier, Paul had written to the saints in Philippi and said, "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor, yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. For I am hard pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better" (Phil. 1:21-23).

Paul knew he was about to achieve his long anticipated goal of going home to be with the Lord. In reality, this is what he had been living for as a Christian. His life and example ought to motivate us to live faithfully till death, knowing we too shall receive "the crown of life" (Jas. 1:12).
